Heaven

The past several weeks I've been reading a book entitled, "The History of Christianity". According to the author, in A.D. 410, the Germanic barbarians known as the Goths sacked the city of Rome. During the invasion, many Christians were put to death in hideous and cruel ways. In the midst of this tragedy, the theologian Augustine (354-430) wrote his classic work, The City of God. His images of what happened to Christians in the face of death are still fresh today.

Augustine wrote, "The end of life puts the longest life on par with the shortest... Death becomes evil only by the retribution which follows it. They, then, who are destined to die need not inquire about what death they are to die, but into **what place death will usher them.**"

For those of us here today who have put our faith in Jesus Christ, death is not a Roman soldier dragging us off to court but a servant ushering us into the presence of a loving Lord. Do you know where death will take you? Can you say boldly with the Apostle Paul, "Death is swallowed up in victory" (**1 Corinthians 15:54**)? I hope you have a desire to go to Heaven after your death. For the Christian, death is not a period but a comma that precedes a glorious eternity with our Lord, Jesus Christ. If we could only realize how wonderful and real Heaven is, I believe that more people in the church would not be so afraid of death. For many, it is dying that makes it hard for them (us) to talk about Heaven. With that said, today we will begin a new series entitled, "Amazing Truths About Heaven: A Real Place, A Real Home" (Part 1).
