Now is the Time to Invest

Is it hard for you to believe that some people openly declare they don't want to go to heaven? I remember one of my relatives telling me that she would rather be in hell than with the church-going crowd in heaven. Most people, however, say they hope to go to heaven when they die. I've often wondered what makes them think they would be happy there. Yes, it's true that heaven is available for everyone, but that doesn't mean they will make heaven their **new address** one day. (see *Matthew 7:13-14*) **Why is that sad but true?**

- They ignore Jesus Christ and want nothing to do with His Father.
- They show no interest in God's Truth (Bible) by reading it and desiring to follow it.
- They also show no interest in worshiping Him and praying to Him.

With that said, why would they suddenly enjoy fellowship with God on the other side **where God dwells?**

When one reads *Psalms 63*, it doesn't take long to realize that David has a deep longing for God. I'm a firm believer that the Godly attitude and actions we are nurturing in our lives **here and now** prepare us for heaven's enjoyment throughout eternity. That raises some heart searching questions for all of us today.

1. We say we want God in our lives, but how passionately do we seek fellowship with Him?
2. How much time do we spend reading His Word, praying, and worshiping?
3. How earnestly do we want to please Him?
4. Does our soul **thirst** for Him and our heart long for Him?

Bottom Line: Now is the time to invest in eternity (Matthew 6:19-21).
